

### **REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA Main figures - Year 2010**

Area: 20 273 km2

Population: 2 046 976 inhabitants

GDP per capita at current prices: 17 576 EUR

- Imports of agricultural products 2.0 billion EUR
- Exports of agricultural products 1.3 billion EUR
- Currency: from January, 2007 EURO
- Agriculture, hunting and fishing (% of total GVA):
  -2010: 2, 4% (1,7% in EU-27)





#### Slovenia is a country with a large number of small farms.



Budget expenditure, grow very rapidly since the year 2001




# CHAMBER OF AGRICULTURE AND FORESTRY OF SLOVENIA










#### **MEMBERS AND MEMBERSHIP FEE**

Chamber's Members are divided into two subgroups: natural persons and legal entities.

- Around 108.000 natural persons and 1.200 legal entities are members of the Chamber.
- The membership fee is determined once per year for the past year.
- The total income of membership fee for 2011 was 2.000.000 €. On average, each member paid €18.



#### **CHAMBER'S ACTIVITIES**

- Represents Members' interests in legislative procedure.
- Informs Members and the public of current issues in agriculture and forestry (free bimonthly bulletin "Zelena Dežela".
- Provides free technical aid in agricultural, forestry, legal and economic consultancy through Agriculture Advisory Service.
