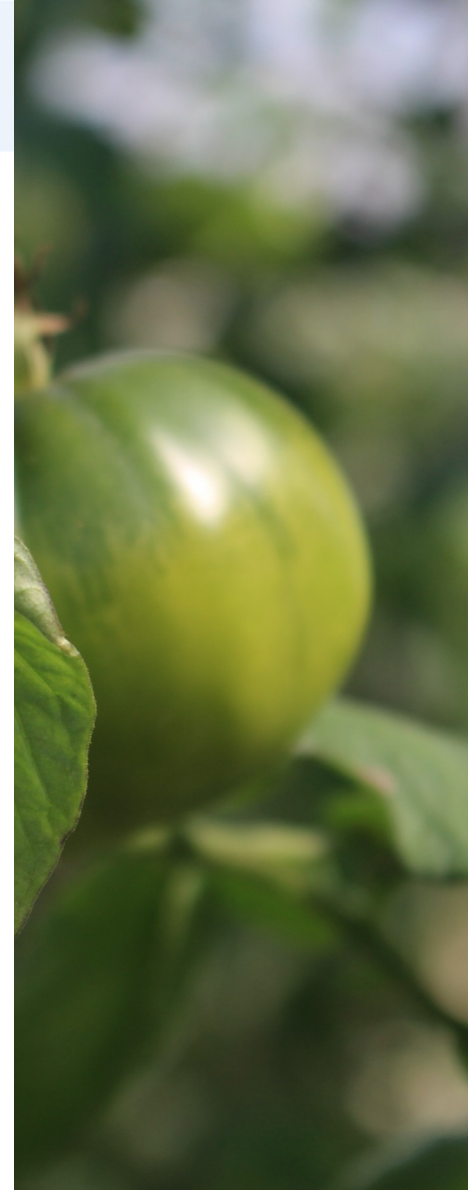


# Self evaluation of Sagiter Activity

## 1 QUANTITATIVE

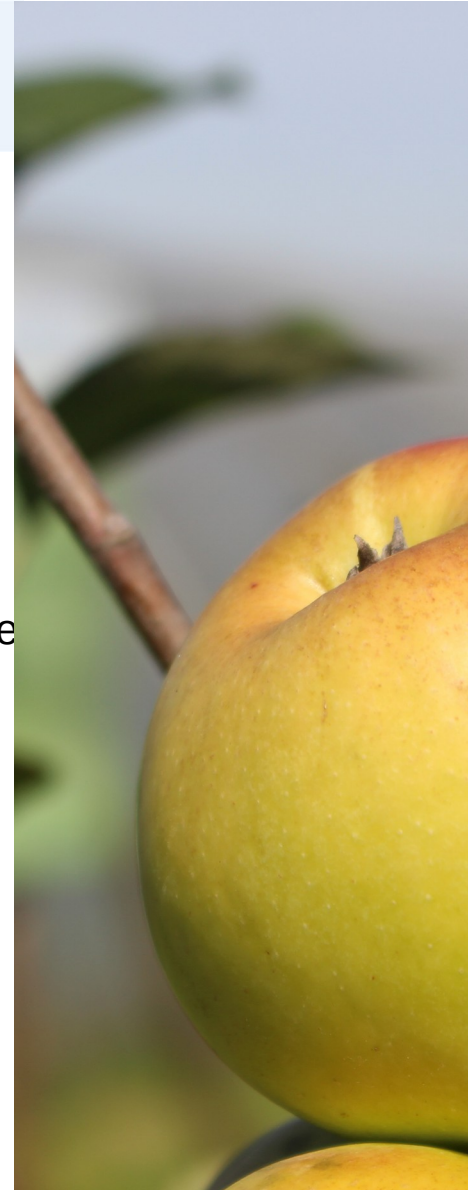
## 2 QUALITATIVE

### **Ecological practices recovered:**

- The ecological hops cultivation in Galicia
- Recovery of local varieties in horticulture (integrated farming, permaculture etc)

### **Methods used:**

- Interviews with actors in the territory: old producers and advisers
- Workgroup by observation and practical work in the territory
- Use of audiovisual tools:
  - Performing video to collect permaculture practice
  - Collection of old photographs and video for recover the historical memory of hops cultivation in Galicia



# Actions done in the territory

- **Meetings with local groups to the collection of information**
- **Conducting surveys:**
  - Adviser of hops cooperative and old hops producers
  - Trainer in bio horticulture and a producer (permaculture)
  - Trainer in integrated agriculture
- **Training sessions: learning by doing adapting to the natural cycles of production**
  - Practice hops cultivation with (18) students (future producers / advisers)
  - Practice in integrated horticulture: 12 with students and farmers
  - Practice in horticulture - permaculture with 7 students
- **Visits for observation / experimentation**
  - Hops cooperative
  - Farm of hops.
  - Beer Galician company - Estrella Galicia
  - Agricultural research center
  - Organic vegetable farm
- **Video made on agroecological practice of permaculture: 3 parts**
  - Visit permaculture farm and interviews to collect information
  - Classroom presentation to students (future producers)
  - Practice done by students in field test





## Current situation in the project

## Difficulties

- The creation of local groups: not tradition of group work - is not sufficiently consolidated this working model
- Administrative difficulties in implementing the transmission model of agroecological knowledge to formal education for youth training.
- Little agroecological culture and therefore little interest in training and professional future project.
