Design of the method of nonformal AE knowledge transfer (Project day – tested at BC Naklo additionaly adapted to different target groups and objectives)

Explaining and discussing the concept of AE: Meetings with teachers and professionals on BC Naklo, Association of organic farmers "Deteljica", Farmers circle organic vegetable farming, Advisors profesional groups at CAFS. Connection with professor A. Vovk from Faculty of Arts of University Maribor - discussion about the agroecologycal perspective of sustainable practices and fitting established practices into AE frame.
