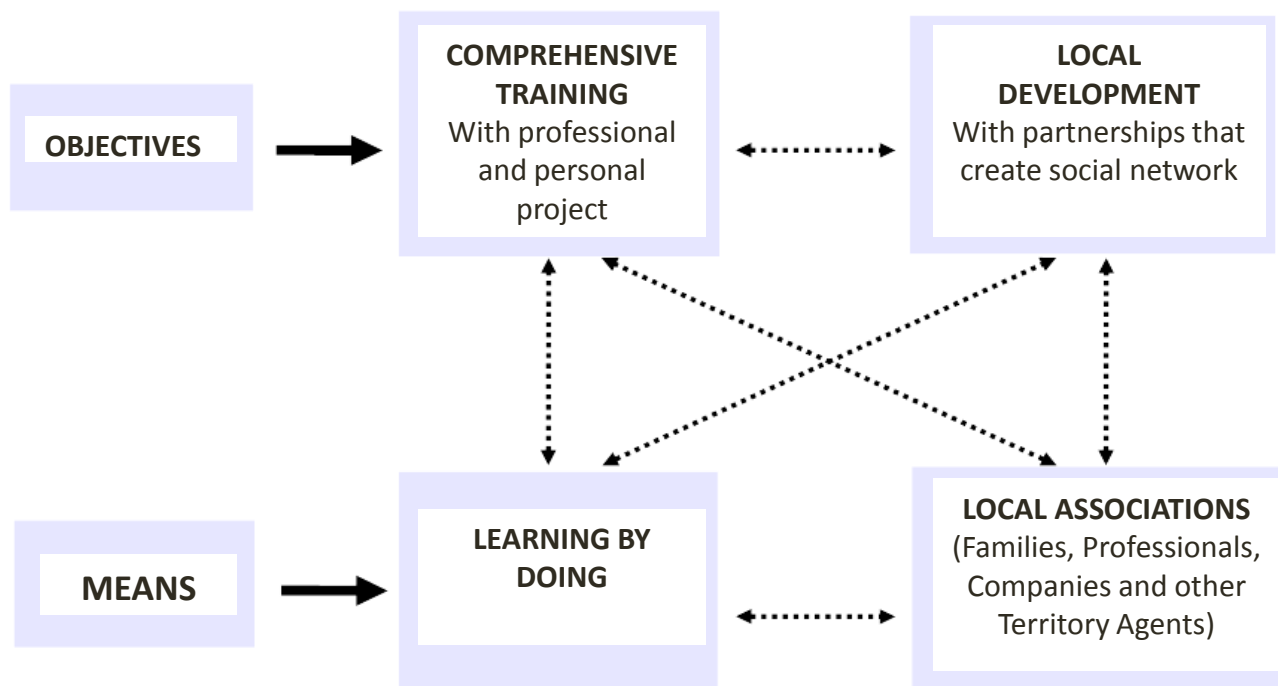

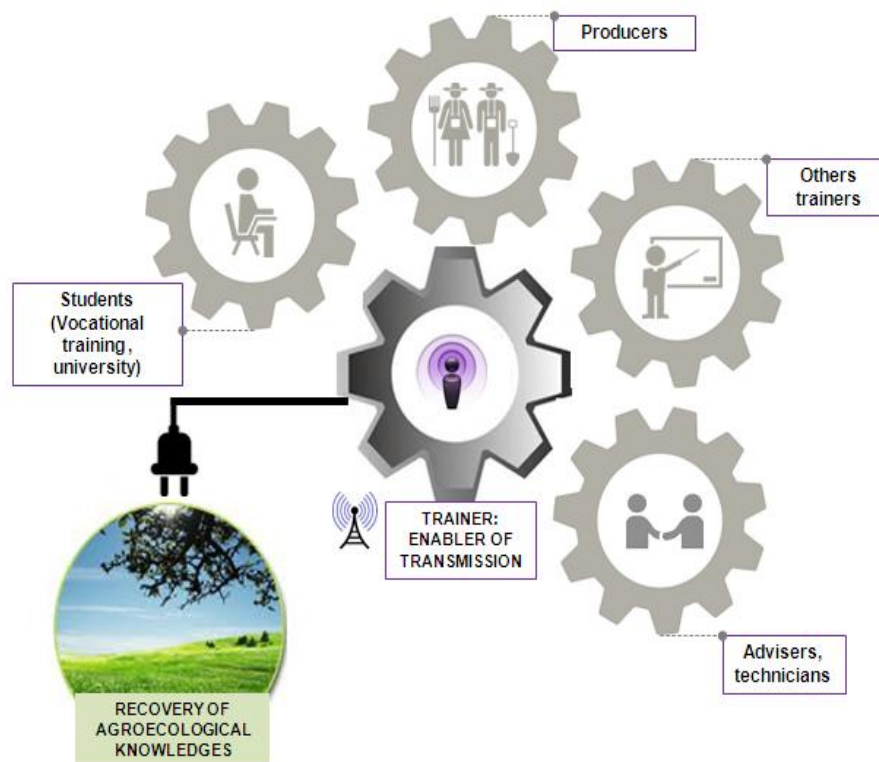




Our target public

Indirect beneficiaries: **students, farmers, development agents, businesses** will be able to be trained, get involved and participate in the content / itineraries elaborated in Sagiter

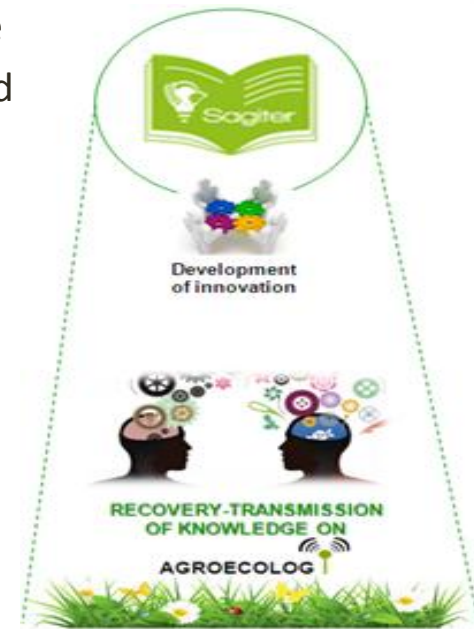
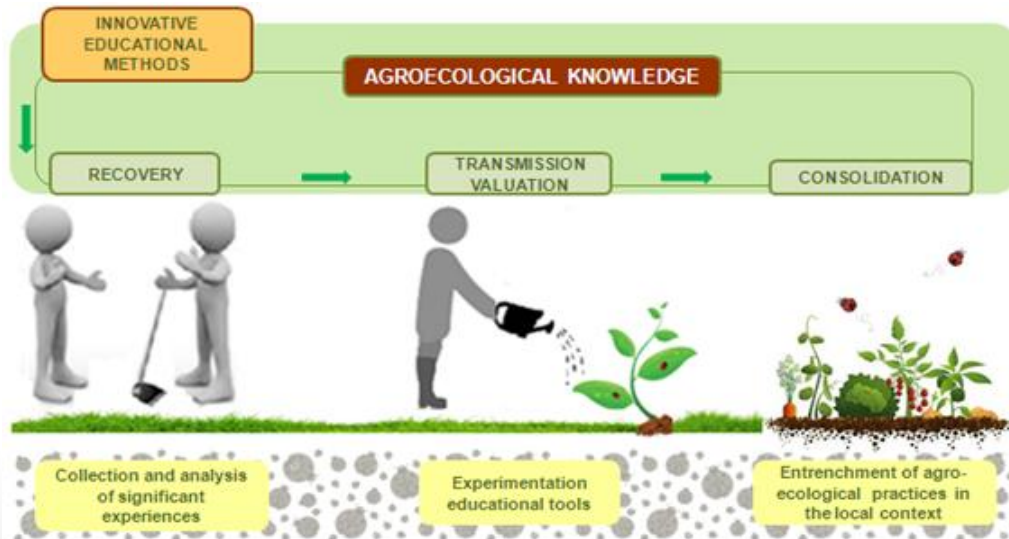

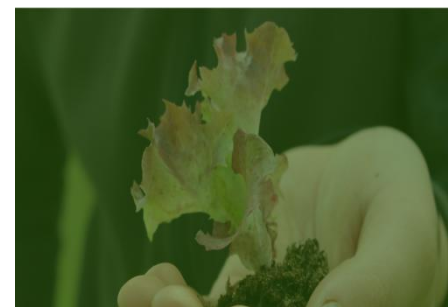

Training sessions

1. Preparatory phase

- a. Preparation work
- b. Collection of information
- c. Analysis of the collected information

2. Training phase with students

- a. Exhibition of information collected in the classroom
- b. Discussion and analysis of information in classroom
- c. Field practices: demonstrations "in situ" of local agroecological practices (test farms, company visits, etc.).
- d. Feedback in the classroom: analysis and collective reflection.

3. Development of training manual (Didactic Unit)



The training sessions respecting the natural cycle of the crop

Training and transmission of agroecological knowledge in the hops cultivation

- Training itinerary duration: 14 days along 10 months
- Target group: trainers, future hop's farmers, students

Training and transmission of Agroecological knowledge in horticultural local varieties of crops

- Training itinerary duration: 8 days along 8 months
- Target group: trainers, potential new producers around the cultivation of local horticultural varieties, students

Recovery and transmission of agroecological knowledge through the permaculture video

- Training itinerary duration: 5 days along 2 months
- Target group: Trainers and students in ecological horticulture





Our actions of ground

- **Creation of workgroups** with involvement of local actors in the territory: trainers, advisers, farmers, students, cooperatives, agents of the local administration, old farmers (retired) = different approaches and opening new channels for the dissemination of results
- **Field experience** = learning by doing
- **Interviews** with old producers / Intergenerational Exchanges = recover traditional know-how
- **Participation in cultural events:** "Green Gold" to recover photos, pictures, films, posters related to the cultivation hops = recovery of historical memory - "the hops cultivation as an economic engine of a territory in the past"
- **Filming** interview of farmer on his farm: "permaculture video" = use tools for demonstration / otherwise transmit information/ trainer's posture



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And tomorrow?

- **Actions for the valorisation of results** in the territory: implementation of methods / tools and devices SAGITER through the networks created in the project (advice, companies, cooperatives, farms, ...)
- **Consolidate the approach of agroecology and learning model SAGITER** in the pedagogy of our training center
- Introduce **the pedagogic device in vocational training** through the material for training of trainers and raise awareness and convince for its use
- **Continuing with dissemination** actions in our region and also through our national network of vocational training centers



Dissemination events

- **May 2016 Meeting** about the recovery of traditional agroecological knowledge in the horticulture. Participants: farmers in horticulture and cooperative's advisers, interested in organic farming and agroecological knowledge
- **July 2016. Participation in Summer School UNEFA (our national network)** in Zaragoza. Presentation of actions and results SAGITER. Participants: trainers of vocational training centers from different regions of Spain
- **September 2016. Participation in a communication conference** organised by the SEPIE (Spanish Service for internationalization of Education) in Santander. Presentation of our experience in the SAGITER project. Participants: trainers and teachers of training centers involved or interested in participating in European programs



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
