- Majer – herd keeper and cheese maker

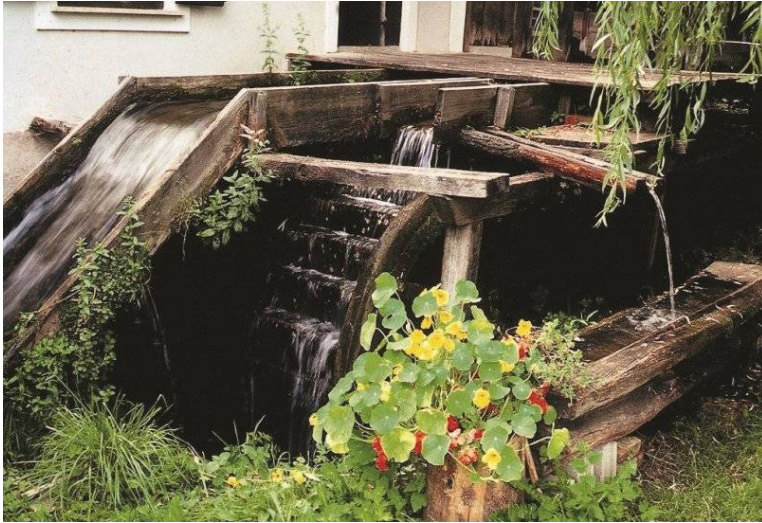


Cheesemaking at Čadrg
